

Open an account, propose your first batch.

Every screen in the order you meet it, with the thing to press ringed on the picture.
Twenty minutes the first time. Ten for every batch after that.

How it works. You propose a batch of one thing. Neighbours reserve it and pay when they reserve. If enough reserve before your deadline, the money is yours before you buy a single ingredient, and you cook. If not enough do, you do not cook and everyone is refunded automatically and in full. Nothing is made in advance.

Have ready. One clear photograph of your face. Three to five of the food. And your numbers: what you want to receive per portion, the fewest portions worth your afternoon, the most you can make in one go.

What it costs. Nothing to join, nothing to list, nothing at all for a batch that does not fill. You name the price you need and you receive it. Our ten percent is added on top and paid by the neighbour; card processing comes out of that, never out of yours.

2 Choose Produce, then fill in three fields.

Produce is what makes this a producer account. You can add Eat later, on the same account.

Fill in your profile.

Four steps with a progress bar. Stop halfway and what you typed is kept.

3 Tick "Cook food", then the basics.

That tick is what reveals the producer sections. Your Kreis is how neighbours near you find your batches; your phone is for us, not for the public.

Be specific rather than broad. "Ligurian focaccia" finds its neighbours; "baking" does not. The story is the part people read twice, so write it the way you would say it aloud.

What you cook

One line and a photograph. The details come later, with the food itself.

What you cook or bake

One line is enough. You pick a category each time you offer something.

The serious page, and a short one. You declare that you cook in a clean private kitchen, that you will list every ingredient and major allergen accurately, and that you stand behind the food you hand over. Read it rather than skim it. Your typed name is the signature, and it is kept with the date.

Your kitchen

This is the part that lets you sell food to a neighbour in Switzerland. It is asked once.

Food-safety self-declaration

All seven. You confirm them once, and we keep a copy on file.

Then a person reads it, usually the same day and always within 48 hours. You get one of three emails: approved and you can open a batch; one specific thing to change, named; or, rarely, that we cannot publish it, with the reason. Nothing is decided by a machine.

Every ingredient in plain language, one per line. The allergen boxes matter most: someone with a nut allergy will read them and trust them. Tick only what is true, and everything that is.

The price you type is the price you receive. Underneath, the page does the arithmetic out loud: what you take home if it just fills, if it sells out, and what the neighbour sees.

What you charge, how small the batch starts, how big it can get.

Below this you do not cook, and every neighbour who reserved is refunded in full, automatically. Set it at the point where the batch is worth your afternoon.

Reservations stop here. Set it at the most you can comfortably cook and hand over in one go.

If it just fills (6), you receive CHF 72.00. If it sells out (20), CHF 240.00. That is your price in full. Neighbours see CHF 13.20, our 10% on top.

Three to five photographs; the first becomes the card. The confirmations are about this batch rather than about you in general: this recipe, these allergens, this pickup. Then your name, and the button.

PART FOUR

After you submit.

What happens, in order.

Within 48 hours	A person reads it. If something needs changing we write and name it. Nothing goes live without you seeing it.
While it is open	Neighbours reserve and pay. Watch the count on your account page. One reminder if it is short and close to the deadline, never two.
It reaches your minimum	Confirmed, and the money is yours before you buy anything.
It closes short	You do not cook. Everyone is refunded automatically and in full, before the pickup day. You owe nothing.
Pickup day	You hand it over yourself, at the window you set. Only the people who collected can review it.

EDIT YOUR DETAILS

What you see of a buyer. First name, how many, what they paid, when, and which pickup. Not their email or phone: that is a promise we make to neighbours and keep in both directions. If somebody does not collect, write to us and we will reach them.

Two things worth remembering. Set your minimum low; a batch of six that fills beats a batch of thirty that does not. And write the story yourself, because the person behind the recipe is what people come back for.
